**FALL FESTIVAL MINUTES**  
**September 24, 2008**

**Call to Order:**

Chairperson Jim Brandenburg brought the meeting to order at 7:04 PM on September 24, 2008.

**Approval of the Agenda:**

A motion was made by Norma Woodman to approve the agenda as presented - seconded by Eva Arnold - motion passed unanimously via a voice vote.

**Approval of the September 11, 2008 Minutes:**

Jim Brandenburg brought up some changes necessary in the 9/11/08 minutes that needed corrections. The secretary will change the original copy of the minutes accordingly. A motion was then made by Kris Wood to approve the minutes with the corrections made - seconded by Bill Rustin - motion passed unanimously via a voice vote.

**Treasurer's Report:**

Kris Wood stated that the balance would be the same as last month or \$2,498.71. Mr. Brandenburg added that a \$200 donation from I. G. Hall came in and was deposited by Margaret Palubinski since the last report and should be added to the total. A motion was then made by Eva Arnold to approve the report as presented with the \$200 donation added to the total - seconded by Rich LeFeber - motion passed unanimously via a voice vote. Norma Woodman then stated that she would be donating her food expenses of \$150 (plus or minus) to the Fall Festival and we thank her for the donation.

**Update on Progress from Event Chairpersons:**

- Fireman's Memorial - Tim Huffman stated that the theme for this year's memorial will be "Prevent Home Fires". He is organizing the event. The Viet Nam Vets will be involved with the program as well. It will start at noon and last approximately 20 minutes. Mr. Brandenburg asked that Rick West be included in the program to play taps. Mr. West will be on site at 12 noon for his part.
- Pedal Tractor Race - a new event is scheduled with red, blue, and green pedal tractors organized by Bill Kutz and Carol Lang. Official flags will be worked into the program as well.
- Beer - donated by Bob Lang (what he has left from his Sept. 27<sup>th</sup> bonfire) The Viet Nam Vets will supply the wagon for the beer, pop, and other refrigerated food. The wagon will be on site where and when we need it. The wagon will be made available to us through Bob Angstrom and the other Viet Nam Veterans group.
- Pumpkin Donations - we will be receiving donations of pumpkins through Carol Lang

and Ed Ensor of at least 30 total.

- Anne's Café - another donator has come forward (Anne Hieder) who will be donating 200 rice crispy squares for children's treats throughout the day as well as the napkin holders for the food area.
- Historical Hayride - Fran will get the required volunteers to drive the tractor and a narrator - otherwise all set up.
- Food - Norma Woodman has the plan well in tact.
- Donation jar(s) - Jacque Patch will prepare.
- Fire Truck Rides - Tim Huffman is ready.
- Quarter Hunt - the committee decided to place quarters in corn after trying both corn and pea gravel. Rich LeFeber will fashion a 10 x 10 sandbox prior to the event. Age groups, time of individual search, and replacement of quarters will be taken into consideration prior to the event.
- Parking - basically anywhere south of the Community Center with committee member parking in the back. Rich LeFeber will organize.
- Smarter than a Fifth Grader - well organized by Sue Brandenburg. She will be assisted by Eva Arnold, her daughter Kathy, and Sara Straub for the actual game.
- Pie Sales - eliminated
- Burlap Sack Race, Balloon Toss, Balloon Launch, Spoon Egg Toss - Kathy Soderberg has the events planned with several volunteers. LeAnn Sullivan will be assisting with the egg toss.
- Patch Train Ride - ready per Fran Patch
- Byerly Balloons - Ethel Maxworthy stated this event is ready.
- Basketball - ready.
- Advertising - ready per Fran Patch.
- Viet Nam Vets - scheduled and ready.
- Ice - should be ready via Don Jones.
- General Store (Prizes) - the old ticket booth will be used by Deb Bennett and Jacque Patch.
- Signage - will be put together per Kathy Soderberg for each event and location.
- Electrical - will be set up by Bill Rustin - music and microphone or PA system.
- Picnic Tables - Bob Lang will loan the tables to the Festival and members will set up prior to noon on Oct. 4<sup>th</sup>.
