**Safety Committee Minutes**  
**October 1, 2008**

Chairman Jere Crouse called the October meeting of the Turtle Safety Committee to order at 7:00 P.M. in the Turtle Community Center.

Roll call was taken with members Roger Fleener, Mike McCabe, Les Oldenburg and Chairman Crouse present. Rich LeFeber represented our police department. Kathy Lenz, Jeff London and Gino Casucci were absent.

Roger Fleener, seconded by Mike McCabe, unanimously approved the agenda on a motion.

The minutes of the previous (September 08) meeting were approved unanimously on a motion by Mike McCabe and second by Roger Fleener.

**Old Business:**

The August 08 Police Department report was handed out for the committee to review.

Vicki Butzler appeared along with Philip and Stephanie Babcock, Jim and Catherine Hull, and Scott Doornbost to present a petition addressed to the Safety Committee, Town Board and Police Department about the continued usage and speeders on Murphy Woods Road. The citizens that live along this road are asking for increased patrolling and more enforcement for speeders and commercial truck traffic. They also need our help with any ideas that can force the speeders to observe the posted speed limit or at least slow down the usage of this road as a quick cut through to reach Prairie Ave. Rich explained our situation and said he would do anything within his power to police this road. Since part of the road is in the city of Beloit, he will ask Beloit to at least locate their trailer in their part of the road to warn the speeders. There are children present along this road that deserve the right to play without dodging speeders. Rich may park our squad car along this road as an additional warning. The citizens also plan to address this issue with an article or letters to the editor of the Beloit Daily News.

The cost to install yellow blinking lights for our Fire Department on our property on County J is about \$1600 and this does not include the signal necessary as a Fire Department truck leaves the station. The Town Board will consider this cost as they prepare the budget for next year.

**New Business:**

There was no further business to discuss.
