### Thermometers and thermostats

Dial-type thermostats and dimmer switches may contain **mercury**. If your contractor does not recycle these items, ask to have it back. **Place intact unit in a spill-proof container, label "Mercury", and call 754-6617 ext. 3.**

**LATEX PAINT** -- CLEAN SWEEP DOES NOT TAKE LATEX PAINT. Harden and leave open cans with regular trash. For large amounts, line a box with a plastic bag and pour up to 1 inch deep, let dry or add absorbent material such as kitty litter, shredded paper, or sawdust.

**Hardened non-lead, non-metallic paints, varnishes** - Remove lids, place next to trash.

Lead paint, all - bring to Clean Sweep

### Batteries

- **Hearing aid, watch:** Batteries Plus or bring to Clean Sweep.
- **Rechargeable:** Batteries Plus or check at [www.rbrc.org](http://www.rbrc.org).
- **Alkaline:** trash or search on-line for mail-in collection boxes.

**Fluorescent bulbs (unbroken)** - ACE Hardware, Lappin Electric (Beloit), URT (formerly CRT Processing), and Menards among others. Ask bulb retailers about programs. Call ahead for tubes. Current list at <http://www.focusonenergy.com>.

### Electronics, TVs, and Computers

**Recycling programs:** URT Processing, Janesville Recycling Center, Best Buy, Goodwill among others (under "Recycling" in phone book).

**Donate for reuse:** Call first! The cost to update equipment may be cost-prohibitive. Ask about data removal procedures

Must be a Rock County resident

## What else should I know?

- No latex paint.
- Fees and/or limits may apply.
- RECYCLE - oil, antifreeze, batteries, tires, electronics, appliances. Ask waste hauler, battery/electronics retailers, auto stores, "recycling" in phone book.

## Accepted Materials:

- Herbicides, insecticides, fungicides, and rodenticides
- Lye and acids
- Solvents (ketone, acetone, turpentine, mineral spirits)
- Liquid lead, enamel, oil-based, and metallic paints. NO LATEX.
- Photographic chemicals
- Acids (sulfuric, muriatic, hydrochloric) and strong bases
- Mercury and mercury-containing devices (thermometers, thermostats, switches, manometers)
- Button batteries
- Pool and spa chemicals, bleaches
- Wood and paint strippers (methyl chloride, others)
- Wood treatments containing penta, creosote, or arsenic
- Non-latex coatings (lacquer, stains, and liquid varnishes)
- Contaminated waste oil and hydraulic fluids
- Flammable materials (lighter fluids, charcoal lighter, kerosene and waste gas)
- Exterior surface coatings (deck stains and driveway sealers, etc.)
- Aerosol cans (not empty)

## Accepted Farm Materials:

- All types of pesticides (herbicides, insecticides, fungicides, and rodenticides)
- Dairy acids
- Hydraulic fluids
- General farm chemicals
- DDT; silvex; heptachlor; dieldrin; lindane; toxaphene; and 2,4,5-T

**Unknown Chemicals:** Accepted in quantities less than 50 pounds or 5 gallons. For larger amounts of unknown chemicals, call 754-6617 ext. 3.

**Drums:** Acceptable if drums have contained or still have agricultural chemicals in them. Other drums may be accepted if they contain significant residues or chemicals considered hazardous. *All drums must be pre-registered. Fees may apply over 20 gallons.*

Home and Farm Rates (2011) ***Pay at event, cash or check only***	
PAINT - Max. 1 bin of paint per home or farm counts toward total bins <b>oil-based, metallic, and lead paint only</b> NO LATEX PAINT! No empty spray cans.	
1 small recycling bin or equivalent (bins will be returned)	FREE
2 <sup>nd</sup> , 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> bin up to 4 total bins	\$5 each
More than 4 bins or equivalent, 10 gallons known material, all barrels, and unknown materials	Call
FLUORESCENT BULBS do not count toward bin total. <b>Please keep separate from other waste.</b> 10 bulb limit, any style. Intact bulbs only.	
First 5 bulbs	FREE
6 to 10 bulbs	\$1 each

## Clean Sweep cannot accept:

- High pressure cylinders,
- Freon gases,
- Infectious and biological wastes,
- Explosives, including detonators and blasting caps, ammunition.
- Radioactive chemicals and devices

## Business Program

Any WI business, school or other agency that generates under 2,200 pounds of hazardous wastes per year (approx. four 55-gallon drums) may be eligible to use Clean Sweep for cost of disposal. Discount for ag chemicals. Businesses save vendor mobilization costs. Pre-registration required. **More information at [www.co.rock.wi.us](http://www.co.rock.wi.us) under 'Land Conservation Department' or 754-6617 ext. 3.** Business services may be available at Clean Sweep in Dane, Jefferson, Walworth Counties. Contact host county for dates and details (search on-line for 'Clean Sweep' and county name).

**Can't get to Clean Sweep?** Help protect your health, the environment, and prevent dangerous situations:

1. Protect your eyes, lungs, and skin when handling chemicals or fragile packages.
2. **DO NOT mix chemicals!**
3. Place fragile or breakable packages in separate leak-proof containers and label "Hazardous!"
4. Store items away from children and pets.
5. **Attach this brochure to storage area so others know what to do.**
