Small Volume Recycling

Recycle Year Round! Many local businesses

accept the following items in **limited quantities** for free or a small fee. **CALL AHEAD.**

- **Earth911.com** lists many local businesses that recycle. Choose from list or type in item.

Recycle locally anytime (5 or fewer items):

- **Fluorescent bulbs:** hardware/home improvement stores, Batteries Plus. Rates and accepted bulb types vary by store; CFLs usually free. Call ahead.

- **Batteries** (rechargeable, hearing aid, watch, cell phone): electronics retailers, Batteries Plus, cell phone stores. Fees if any vary. Call ahead.

- **Electronics, computers, printers,** keyboards, speakers, mice, DVD players, VCRs, DVRs, fax machines, cell phones, appliances, more. URT, Goodwill, electronics stores, more at Earth911.

- **Computers for reuse:** Ask recycler or refurbisher about data removal procedures.

- **Fire extinguishers:** call local fire safety suppliers.

Latex paint – Make solid. Air-dry or add kitty litter or shredded paper. Leave open cans with trash. For large amounts, line box with plastic, pour 1 inch deep, harden.

Latex paint recycling - earthpaintscs.com lists Harris Ace Hardware in Janesville and Beloit. Call stores for details.

Hardened non-lead, non-metallic paints, varnishes – Remove lids, place with trash.

Any WI business, agency or organization that is a VSQG (at far right) can bring waste to a Clean Sweep event for cost of disposal.

Our waste vendor can help you determine your status.

To use business program in Rock County:

1. Must be an eligible VSQG from any WI county.
 2. Get a FREE, NO-OBLIGATION quote
 - Complete the chemical inventory
www.co.rock.wi.us/clean-sweep
or call 608-754-6617 ext. 3.
 3. If you like the quote, confirm your drop-off with the vendor and deliver your waste to a Clean Sweep drop-off site in Rock County.
- **No ag chemical discount in Rock County for 2012.

To use business program in Dane County:

- Must be an eligible VSQG from any WI county.
- Must pay disposal cost and transport waste.
- **Open all year. Appointments required.**
- Go to Dane County Business Clean Sweep
danecountycleansweep.com/business.aspx
- Review program information
- No ag chemical discount for Rock County businesses.

To use business program in Walworth County:

- Must be an eligible VSQG from any WI county.
- **Pre-registration required, contact below.**
- Must pay disposal cost and transport waste.
- October 5, 9:00 am – 12:00 pm, Elkhorn.
- No ag chemical discount for Rock County businesses.

What is a VSQG?

A very small quantity generator, VSQG, is defined by the following criteria:

(a) In every single month during the calendar year, the site generated less than 100 kg. (220 lbs.) of hazardous waste, and 1 kg. (2.2 lbs.) or less of acute hazardous waste, and 100 kg. (220 lbs.) or less of acute hazardous waste spill cleanup material; and

(b) the site accumulated at any time during the calendar year 1,000 kg. (2,205 lbs.) or less of hazardous waste, and 1 kg. (2.2 lbs.) or less of acute hazardous waste, and 100 kg. (220 lbs.) or less of acute hazardous waste spill cleanup material.

- High pressure cylinders
- Freon gases
- Infectious and biological wastes
- Explosives, detonators, blasting caps
- Radioactive chemicals and devices
- Ammunition
